How to compute the Score: [per individual]

1. Find the Weighted Score (WS) of each item.
2. Find the sum of the Weighted Score (WS) in each table.
3. Find the Average Weighted Score (AWS) by dividing the WS in each table by the number of item in that particular table.
4. Find the sum of AWS.
5. Refer Table 1 for the description and remark of the sum of AWS.

How to compute the Score: [for consolidation]

1. Find the Weighted Score (WS) of each item: [score of column 1] + [2 x score of column 2] + [3 x score of column 3] + [4 x score of column 4].
2. Find the sum of the Weighted Score (WS) in each table.
3. Find the Average Weighted Score (AWS) in each table: $WS \div [\text{number of item in that particular table} \times \text{sample size}]$.
4. Find the sum of AWS.
5. Refer Table 1 for the description and remark of the sum of AWS.
